

A Vintage Baby Bib

For the duck embroidery pattern use an iron-on transfer pen such as the ones from Sulky – available at most craft stores or www.sulky.com and trace the design (all solid lines). Following the directions that came with your pen, transfer the pattern to a light colored pastel fabric of your choice. Embroider the pattern on the fabric.

Cut out bib pattern and join together. Fold embroidered in half and place bib pattern over fabric making sure to center duck on the bib. Pin pattern in place and cut out fabric. Place pattern on a coordinating fabric and cut out back side of bib.

With wrong sides together, stitch around edges leaving a 1/4 inch seam. Leave a small opening along the bottom. Turn right side out. Top stitch the opening closed and around entire bib. Add snaps or hook and loop tape in correct place.
